# WHAT IS MACHANEH?

At Habonim Dror we work hard to create a unique inclusive atmosphere that makes our Machaneh (summer camp) a home away from home for every child.

Whilst a number of chanichim (participants) will have been on a Habonim Dror Machaneh before, we always welcome new members on summer camp. Our madrichim (leaders) create a caring and happy environment, encouraging the chanichim to make new friends and make the most out of this memorable residential experience.

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## KVUTSOT

On arrival at camp, chanichim will be split into smaller kvutzot (tiyul groups) of around 10-12 girls and boys, accompanied by 3-4 madrichim (leaders). These groups will be mixed, allowing chanichim to bond with new friends, and rekindle old friendships. The kvutzot remain their 'camp families' for the duration of Machaneh.



## TIYUL

With the exception of Efrochim, who go on a one night tiyul midway through camp, all chanichim begin their Machaneh experience with several days' tiyul (hiking) through the countryside.

In their kvutzot, the chanichim travel on foot from one campsite to the next, breaking throughout the day for activities or relaxation. They will enjoy lunch in the local villages or the beach.

During this time, they get the opportunity to participate in varied outdoor activities such as abseiling, rock climbing, visiting funfairs and spending time on the beach.

## UNDER THE STARS

During tiyul, the chanichim sleep in tents, enjoy barbecues and traditional Habonim Dror campfire singalongs.

Tiyul is truly the most unique of all Habonim experiences... Years later, people still talk about tiyul as their favourite Habo memory.



# WELCOME TO MEGASITE!

After a fun-filled adventure on tiyul, the chanichim are welcomed onto the Habonim Dror Megasite. This is a purpose-built, well-equipped and secure 100 acre site in the Welsh countryside which has a farm, river, cabins and 10,000 sq. ft. activity hall.

## WHAT HAPPENS AT MEGASITE?

Megasite houses four of our summer camps for ages 9 – 14. This enables the chanichim to be part of a huge Habo Machaneh experience whilst also engaging in separate activities with their peers tailored specifically for their particular age group.

### FUN

Habo summer camps always involve large-scale fun activities such as a Colour Wars, Murder Mystery, Habolympics, camp fires and barbecues. Chanichim have fun learning about Habonim Dror, Israel and their Jewish identity and values.

1. No applicant will be allowed to participate in a camp unless Habonim Dror has received (a) a fully completed medical and consent form, and (b) full payment, unless alternative arrangements have been made prior to the specified date.

2. The deposit is non-refundable and the balance is non-refundable after the closing date stated in the brochure.

3. Places on each Habonim Dror summer camp are limited, and completion of this form does not guarantee acceptance.

4. The prices and dates stated in the brochure are subject to confirmation. Any changes will be published as soon as they are known.

5. The leaders of the camp reserve the right to send home any participant that is considered unsuitable for the camp. Should any participant be sent home for contravening the rules of the camp set down by Habonim Dror or have to return home due to illness or from their own volition, their parents/guardians will be liable for all the travel costs incurred and may, at the discretion of the leaders, be required to collect their child. In such circumstances, NO refund will be given.

6. Only for very special reasons will a child be permitted to arrive late or leave early from any camp or be taken away from the camp at any time, and then only with prior arrangement and when the child is accompanied by an agreed adult.

7. It is a legal responsibility that everyone on a private bus/coach is required to wear a seatbelt. Should my child not be wearing one and is subsequently fined by the authorities, I take full responsibility for the necessary fees.

8. It is Habonim Dror's policy that participants are not permitted to take mobile phones on camp. If one is brought, it will be withheld for the duration of the camp but Habonim Dror cannot be held responsible for its safe return. These items are not covered on the insurance policy.

## **LEARNING ABOUT THE HOLOCAUST**

We take advantage of the Dutch sunshine and run as many activities as possible in the beautiful fields of our long-standing site. As with the other Machanot, Sayarim begins with a four night expedition on tiyul exploring the Dutch countryside and enjoying the usual campfire ruach.

# FAQ

## **Q What does a typical day on camp look like?**

**A** There is no such thing as a 'typical day'. However, each day will consist of a number of educational peulot (activities) as well as kef (fun) peulot. A number of special traditional activities which have become synonymous with Machaneh will also be run for chanichim over the course of their camp, including Colour Wars, Habolympics, chuggim (a choice of activities), camp fires and the legendary Murder Mystery.

## **Q What happens if my child is unwell / in case of medical emergency?**

**A** Fully qualified medics are present onsite at all times for the duration of camp. In addition to this, all madrichim are trained to deal with basic first-aid and welfare issues, with Roshim (heads of camp) having received extensive welfare training on such matters as physical and/or mental issues to homesickness and first periods. Please be assured our madrichim are prepared for any problem that may arise during camp. It is important to us that your child is in the safest hands possible on a Habonim Dror Machaneh.

## **Q Can I contact my child whilst they are away on camp?**

**A** In order to encourage chanichim to be fully engaged, not only in our activities but also in their own social activities, Habonim Dror Summer Machanot operate a strict no-mobile phone policy. This also ensures the safety and security of all those involved as it would be impossible for us to monitor social media posts etc. It also minimises the potential for home-sickness. However, each chanich/a will be able to make at least one phone call home toward the middle of the main-site part of camp, and if they wish to call home in addition to this, they are welcome to do so.

We email weekly updates to parents and post on Facebook several times each week, so you will get a good idea of what your child is up to.

Our team of movement workers are contactable 24 hours a day in case of an emergency.

## **Q Who will be looking after / running activities for my children?**

**A** Each camp has its very own tzevet (leadership team) of between 10 and 15 madrichim (leaders). The madrichim on each tzevet will consist of a mixture of ages and will represent a balance of genders. Every madrich/a has been DBS checked.

Each tzevet will be led by two Roshim (heads of camp) who are responsible for organising their tzevet and ensuring their Machaneh is running smoothly and efficiently. Roshim will also ensure that any welfare issues that arise over the course of Machaneh are dealt with swiftly and appropriately – so that every camper is a happy camper.

Each camp will also have designated rakazim (organisers) who are responsible for overseeing the logistical needs of the camp, as well as making sure the camp's kitchens and store rooms stay fully stocked. There will also be movement workers (full-time employees of Habonim Dror) on Megasite for the duration of Machaneh, who are fully contactable should any emergencies arise over the duration of camp.
